Show Terms and Conditions

PLEASE DO NOT LIGHT FIRES OR BARBEQUES (EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS).
DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES UNATTENDED.

- Display vehicles should be in position by 10am (gates open 8am) on Saturday & Sunday and should not normally leave before 4pm.
- Vehicle passes are for display vehicles, if you are bringing your display vehicle on a trailer you will need an event support vehicle pass. Please answer 'Yes' to Trailer question to receive one of these. Once the display vehicle has been unloaded the event support vehicle and trailer must leave the arena and park at the top of the site (behind the control building). Please note that vehicles with a disabled badges are also not allowed on the arena (unless they are a display vehicle), they should be parked in the appropriate disabled parking area.
- Un-restored vehicles may be permitted (at the organisers discretion) by prior acceptance. Such vehicles will be trailed to the show and must have the appropriate insurance.
- All vehicles driven to the show must have Road Tax, MOT (where applicable) and at least Third Party Insurance.
- Only vehicles displaying a Vehicle pass will be allowed into the display areas. All other vehicles will be directed to the public parking areas.
- Display locations and movement of display vehicles are under the control of the show organisers.
- Clubs will select vehicles to parade in the show ring at specified times (numbers may be restricted to meet time schedules).
- The British Motor Museum and grounds are open to the public from 10am—5pm.
- Attendance at the show and camping/caravanning or parking is at your own risk.
- Toilets and showers will be available on site for campers but there will not be any electric hook-ups.
- With exception of guide dogs, we regret that pets are not permitted anywhere in the museum. Pets must be kept on a lead at all times.
- All tickets are non-refundable.
