Leave the car at home – can you travel in a group by coach or taxi share. If you are travelling by car, please speak to our team about carbon offsetting options.

Bring a reusable cup – you can use any reusable cup in the café, to reduce wastage from single-use cups.

Event signage – Do you have signage from a previous event that could be reused. Do you have a digital solution rather than using paper.

Turn off the lights – every time you all leave the room, switch off the lights to save energy.

Turn off the screens – help save energy by turning them off it not being used. **Return your stationery** – if you have anything left over, offer it to your team or leave it at reception where we will be happy to repurpose it.

Reduce, reuse, recycle – we provide bins for general waste as well as mixed recycling so encourage you to deposit of your waste responsibly.
