# REDUCING ENERGY CONSUMPTION

Installed; LED lighting throughout, low energy hand dryers, solar PV array panels and a Building Management System that automatically optimises the heating and air conditioning. Equipped the main kitchen with state-of-the-art low energy ovens and refrigeration equipment. Installed 10 EV charging points.

#### WATER MANAGEMENT

Installed; dual flush toilets, waterless urinals, sensor taps Sedum roofs, and a network of lakes to collect rainwater and slowly release it to avoid flash flooding. An in-house bottling plant provides sparkling and still filtered table water in reusable glass bottles.






# CONFERENCE & EXHIBITION SUITE





# LECTURE ROOMS




