How to Book Online

- Visit the British Motor Museum website (britishmotormuseum.co.uk) and click the red 'EVENT TICKETS' box at the top right of the page
- Scroll through the calendar and choose your Show
- Underneath the Show description you will see red boxes with the ticket options for that particular show (Saturday/Sunday/Weekend where appropriate)
- Click on the box for the day(s) you wish to attend the show, then confirm your arrival day on the calendar that appears.
- You will then be presented with a selection of ticket options, you will need to select Vehicle Exhibitor, enter the number of vehicles you wish to enter. Add any other tickets that you require and then scroll to the bottom to click 'Add to Basket'
- Add the details of your vehicle entry, then click 'Update basket' and then click 'Continue'.
- Now add your name and address details and click 'Continue'
- The final page will ask you to read the Ts and Cs, tick the box, click continue, make any payment that's due and you are all done!
- A confirmation email will be sent to you, and your passes will be posted out a couple of weeks before the show

- BMIHT reserves the right to refuse admission should visitors breach any Rules and Regulations.
- Display vehicles should be in position by 10am (gates open 7.30am) and should not normally leave before the show finishes. Display locations and movement of display vehicles are under the control of the show organisers.
- Vehicle passes are for display vehicles, If you are bringing your display vehicle on a trailer once the display vehicle has been unloaded the event support vehicle and trailer must leave the arena and park at the top of the site (behind the control building). Please note that vehicles with a disabled badge are also not allowed on the arena (unless they are a display vehicle), they should be parked in the appropriate disabled parking area. All other vehicles will be directed to the public parking areas.
- Un-restored vehicles may be permitted (at the organisers discretion) by prior acceptance. Such vehicles will be trailed to the show and must have the appropriate insurance.
- All vehicles driven to the show must have Road Tax, MOT (where applicable) and at least Third Party Insurance.
- Clubs will select vehicles to parade in the show ring at specified times (numbers may be restricted to meet time schedules).
- The British Motor Museum and grounds are open to the public from 10am—5pm.
- Attendance at the show and camping/caravanning or parking is at your own risk.
- Toilets and showers will be available on site for campers but there will not be any electric hook-ups.
- With exception of assistance dogs, we regret that pets are not permitted anywhere in the museum. Pets must be kept on a lead at all times.
- All tickets are non-refundable.
- We regret that we cannot accept responsibility or liability for theft, loss or injury on this site under any circumstances.
- All Children under 16 MUST be accompanied by an Adult whilst in the Museum Buildings.
