On arrival, it is the responsibility of the camper to report to the Campsite Officer to agree pitching instructions. Do not arrive before the campsite opens at 4.00pm on Saturday 20 July, as the marshal will not be available for check-in. Gates will be closed each night at 9.00pm until 7.30am the next day.  The Pitch:  Caravans and tents must be pitched at a minimum of 6 metres apart and in a position agreed with the Campsite Officer, leaving access to the water supplies for fire fighting.  No holes, pits or drainage channels should be dug on the site without the express consent of the Campsite Officer.  Pitches must be kept tidy and left clean on vacating the site.
