- Display vehicles should be in position by 10am (gates open 7.30am) and should not normally leave before the show finishes. Display locations and movement of display vehicles are under the control of the show organisers.
- Vehicle passes are for display vehicles, If you are bringing your display vehicle on a trailer once the display vehicle has been unloaded the event support vehicle and trailer must leave the arena and park at the top of the site (behind the control building). Please note that vehicles with a disabled badge are also not allowed on the arena (unless they are a display vehicle), they should be parked in the appropriate disabled parking area. All other vehicles will be directed to the public parking areas.
- Un-restored vehicles may be permitted (at the organisers discretion) by prior acceptance. Such vehicles will be trailered to the show and must have the appropriate insurance.
- All vehicles driven to the show must have Road Tax, MOT (where applicable) and at least Third Party

Insurance.
• Clubs will select vehicles to parade in the show ring at specified times (numbers may be restricted to meet time schedules).
 The British Motor Museum and grounds are open to the public from 10am—5pm.
 Attendance at the show and camping/caravanning or parking is at your own risk.
 Toilets and showers will be available on site for campers but there will not be any electric hook-ups.
 With exception of assistance dogs, we regret that pets are not permitted anywhere in the museum.
All tickets are non-refundable.
