Upgrade to the Premier Certificate, which includes all the information provided on a Heritage Certificate and also incorporates a photograph of your car, provided by you.

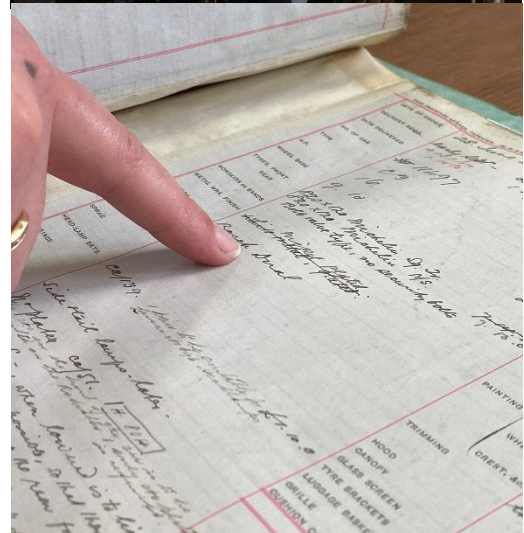
Heritage Document Wallets
